## 1 General Safety Information

- The Form 2 contains a Class 3B laser, but is classified as Class 1 as interlocks prevent laser exposure in normal use. Opening the front or back panels may present a risk of Class 3B laser exposure.
- Gloves should be worn when handling resin. Each type has a SDS detailing specific chemical hazards that can be found at <http://formlabs.com/products/3d-printers/tech-specs/#material-properties>.
