

## **NOTICE: New Faculty of Medicine Protocol for Chemical Waste labelling**

In an effort to increase the level of safety in our research labs, especially in shared or open concept spaces, the Faculty of Medicine Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) is introducing a new CHEMICAL WASTE label.


This new CHEMICAL WASTE label should be applied to bottles being re-used for chemical waste on both the lid (top) and side of bottle. This new label should be used <u>in addition to</u> the standard red and white EHS Chemical Waste label, which is still mandatory and required by EHS for disposal.

The new labels will ensure bottles being re-used for chemical waste are more clearly marked and also marked in a consistent manner across all labs in the faculty.

Labels will be distributed to departmental offices and will be available at MedStores in the basement of MSB.



Place green CHEMICAL WASTE label on the lid (top) of bottle being re-used for chemical waste collection.



Place green CHEMICAL WASTE label on side of bottle being re-used for chemical waste collection.

As per existing protocol, ensure the original label is defaced and EHS's Chemical Waste label (red and white) is also applied.
